Sexual Assault

In April of 2013, 17 year old Nathan Pearson died after attempting to take her own life. She and her family contacted her death to investigate harassment and bullying she experienced while at school and online after pictures of a sexual assault were shared among her peer group.

Nathan's tragic story has touched the lives of many across the country and around the world, and caused the formation of the National Day of Remembrance and Action on Violence Against Women.
